UK Entry Requirements – Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA)

Visitors traveling to the UK must obtain either a visa or an Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) before departure. Travellers without one will be denied boarding by airlines, ferry companies, or rail operators. Check if you require any of these documents: <https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa>

- British and Irish citizens are exempt from the ETA requirement.
- Dual nationals must travel using a valid British or Irish passport or a Certificate of Entitlement.
- Apply at least three working days before travelling.

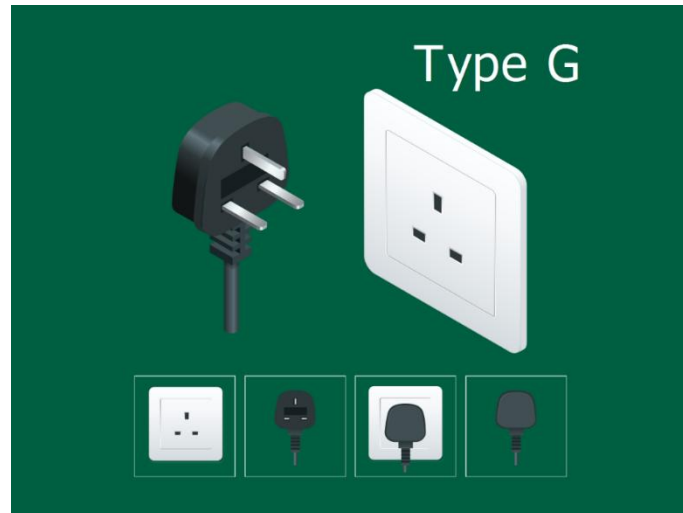

Electricity & Power Adapters

The United Kingdom uses plug Type G (three rectangular pins in a triangular layout, BS 1363 standard), which is different from the continental European Type C/E/F plugs. Visitors from mainland Europe and most other countries will need a Type G travel adapter.

- Voltage: 230 V | Frequency: 50 Hz (same electrical standard as continental Europe).

- Plug type: G – three flat rectangular pins. Widely available to purchase at airports and electronics shops.
- Most hotels provide a UK–EU adapter on request; it is safer to bring your own.

By Underground (Tube)

- Mornington Crescent (Northern Line) – approx. 5-minute walk south.
- Camden Town (Northern Line) – approx. 10-minute walk south.
- King's Cross St. Pancras (Northern, Victoria, Piccadilly, Circle, Metropolitan, and Hammersmith & City lines) – approx. 15-minute walk or short bus ride.

By Train

- King's Cross / St. Pancras International (Eurostar, Caledonian Sleeper, Great Northern, Thameslink, LNER, and EMR) – take the Northern Line to Mornington Crescent (2 stops) or walk (~15 min).
- Euston – Northern Line one stop to Mornington Crescent, or ~20-minute walk.

By Bus

- Routes 1, 24, 27, 29, and 253 stop on Camden High Street, a short walk from the campus.
- Route 46 stops at Royal Veterinary College (Stop P).

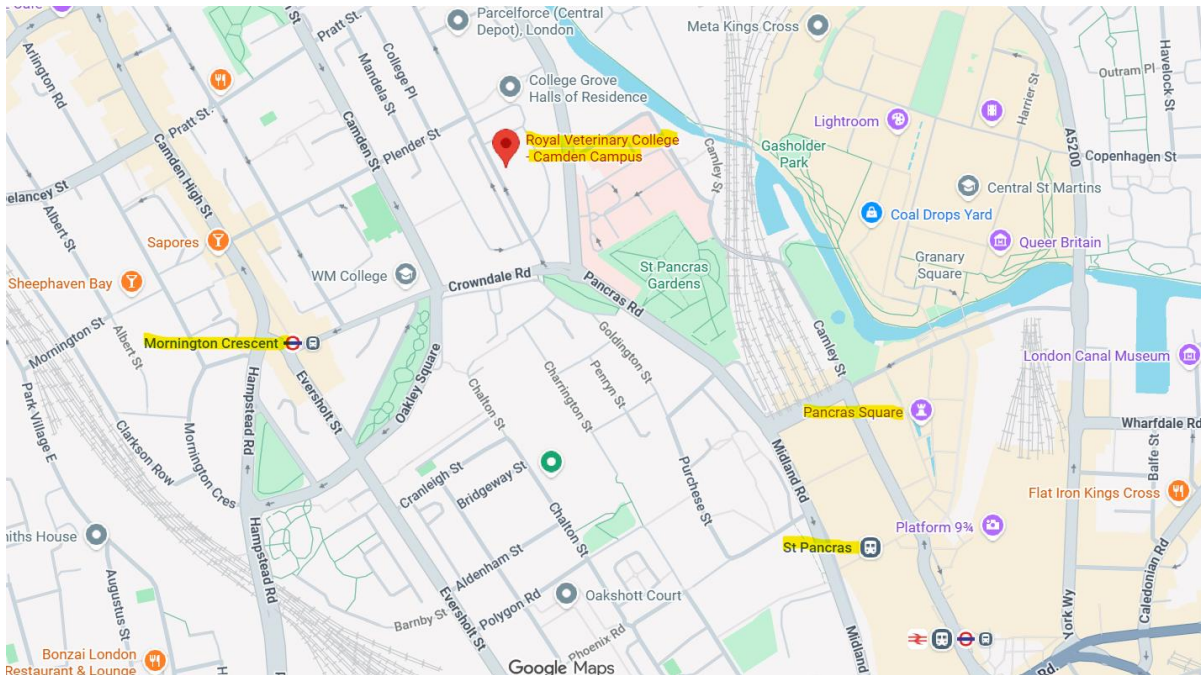
From Airports

- **Heathrow (LHR):** Elizabeth line (Crossrail) to Tottenham Court Rd, then Northern Line northbound (~55 min).
- **Gatwick (LGW):** Gatwick Express or Thameslink to St. Pancras / King's Cross, then Northern Line (~55 min).
- **Stansted (STN):** Stansted Express to Liverpool Street, change to Tube (Northern Line via King's Cross, ~70 min).

- **Luton (LTN):** DART to Luton DART Parkway, then 2 mins and change to EMR until St Pancras International then walk 15 mins (~50 min).
